Eligibility

Swimmers must be registered member of a Brisbane club affiliated with Swimming Queensland. Swimmers meeting this requirement who do not have Australian Citizenship may compete as visitors, in heats only and are not eligible for medals or points. Members of overseas swimming federations, interstate clubs and other regions are ineligible to compete at the championships. It is the responsibility of each club to verify the eligibility of swimmers nominated by them.

Age

Age group of competitors for this meet is the age as at the first day of competition (i.e. 25 February 2017). Minimum age is 8 years. Athletes cannot swim 'up' an age in individual events.

Qualifying Times

Qualifying times must have been achieved at an approved meet on or after 1 January 2017.

Entries will not be accepted unless the qualifying times have been swum at a sanctioned Short Course or Long Course Qualifying Meet prior to this Championships' closing date. Long Course converted times can be used. Club night, club championships, no times or NT are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

If there is no qualifying time stated for your age group, you cannot compete in the event/s concerned.

Multi Class Events

There are no qualifying times for Multi Class events.

SWD competitors swimming in events that are not designated as Multi Class must produce their exemption cards to the session Referees.

Late Entries

All entries submitted after this time will incur a late nomination fee of \$50.00 per event.

Late entries will be accepted in the timing room up until one hour before the commencement of the first day of competition. Late entries are subject to lane availability in the event, and may result in swimmers being entered in the slowest heat.

Rules

All Swimming Queensland General Rules, Championship By-Lays, FINA & SAL swim rules apply.

Events & Medals

Medals will be awarded to age group as follows:

50m Events	8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs
100m Freestyle	9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs
100m IM	10yrs
Other 100m Events	11yrs, 12yrs
200m IM	11yrs, 12yrs
200m/400m Freestyle	11yrs, 12yrs
Other 200m Events	12yrs
400m IM	12yrs
800m Freestyle	12yrs

Medals will not be awarded if qualifying times have not been met.

Finalist Ribbons will be awarded to non-place-getters in each final. Where there are timed finals, the next 7 time-placed swimmers after the place-getters will receive Top Ten Ribbons.

Multi Class Events

Multi Class events are conducted as 'Open Events' and will be awarded medals accordingly, as determined using the Multi Class Points Score System. Medals will not be awarded in individual age groups.

Pool Deck Entry (Coaches & Team Managers)

Coaches must present either their current ascta membership card or pool deck accreditation pass to gain free entry to the meet and access pool deck. Coaches who do not hold a current ascta membership card, Team Managers and support staff who have athletes competing and require a pool deck accreditation for access during the Championships MUST apply by emailing admin@brisswim.org.au no later than 5pm Thursday 8 March for accreditation passes to be available for collection at the front ticketing desk during the Championship.

Points will be awarded in all divisions.

Major Awards

The following major awards will be presented at the Brisbane Awards Day:

Marilyn Carseldine Trophy – *Best All Round Performance*

Earn McAuliffe Trophy – *Best Performance in Form Strokes*

SWD Swimmer of the Meet – *Best Performance in Multi Class Events*

Towel Awards

Towels will be awarded to the male and female swimmers who score the highest number of points in their own age group (i.e. 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs and 12yrs). The male and female Swimmer with Disability with the highest number of points will also be presented with a towel award. Points will be awarded as follows:

1 st	6 Points
2 nd	3Points
3 rd	1 point
